



PACKING LIST

- Sketchbook
- Pencils and erasers
- Markers or colored pencils
- Flash drive
- Backpack
- Sleeping bag or sheets and blanket (Twin XL)
Participants may wish to bring an extra blanket as residence halls can be cooler than expected.
- Pillow and pillowcase
- Bath towel and wash cloth
- Toiletries (shampoo, conditioner, body wash, toothbrush, toothpaste, deodorant, etc.)
- Shower shoes (flip flops)
- Alarm clock or cell phone with alarm
- Umbrella or raincoat
- Hat and sunscreen
- Reusable water bottle
- Casual summer clothing
- One outfit you don't mind getting dirty
